Generous supply of wooden No. 2 pencils w/ eraser (**NO Mechanical Pencils**) (leads break easily and becomes a distraction to students)

1 hand-held pencil sharpener (w/ lid to catch shavings)

1 - pkg of highlighters: at least four colors.

1 pkg crayons, markers, or colored pencils (pick one)

5 black or blue "Dry Erase" markers (either wide tip or fine point ok)

1 pair of scissors

1- Agenda Book (Student will bring 5.00 to school on the first day to purchase.)

- 1) **HAVE A GRRRRRRREAT SUMMER! LAUGH, PLAY OUTSIDE, TRAVEL, LISTEN TO MUSIC, DANCE, ENJOY FAMILY, AND ETC.**

- 2) **UPGRADE YOURSELF! HOW?? EXPLORE ONE/OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:**
 - A) **Pick a place you want to visit somewhere in the world (possibly another country?). Explore what sites there are to see and what culture the place has to offer.**
 - B) **Pick a skill/ability you would like to gain and PRACTICE IT. Some examples: learn a new language (start by learning several phrases with good pronunciation) , learn to play an instrument (guitar, piano, drums, violin, etc.), learn a new dance (become good confident enough to dance in front of others, learn a new tech skill (create a simple app or video game, learn video or music creating programs, create a website, etc), learn a new sport (join a team), and/or anything else you have a passion for (designing clothes, art (paintings), building complex models, writing a story/comic book, etc).**
 - C) **Contribute! Do a little or lot of something to make the world a little better. How? Some examples: start a recycling system at home (that works, volunteer (homeless or animal shelter), help your parents with work, & etc.**

***FINALLY: Be ready to present your experience, learned skill/ability, and/or new knowledge at the beginning of next year. I will ask you: How have you upgraded yourself over this past summer?**
